


NON-DESTRUCTIVE, SCALABLE, **SMART MONITORING OF REMOTE CULTURAL TREASURES** 



**ARGUS** is a European research project that aims to advance the development of digital tools for the preventive conservation and effective remote monitoring of cultural heritage.

The objective of the ARGUS project is to preserve remote cultural heritage by applying state-of-the-art monitoring technologies, both terrestrial and airborne, and digitisation and artificial intelligence techniques for the early identification and detection of threats.

This ambitious three-year initiative will test new methodologies at five pilot sites across Europe.









